



**INSTRUCTIONS ON THE 18th NATIONAL AGRICULTURAL SHOW TO BE HELD
FROM 18th June to 27th June 2025**

The National Agriculture Show has been held 17 times and has gradually developed into one of the largest regional agricultural fairs, especially within the East African Community. It has become highly influential in agribusiness development. Aiming to enhance business prosperity and technology transfer in agriculture, the show focuses on participation, exchange, forums, trade talks, and scientific and agricultural commercial activities. The 18th National Agricultural Show is scheduled to take place at the MULINDI Agricultural Showground in Gasabo District, Kigali City, from 18th June to 27th June 2025.

Below, we provide information, rules, and regulations for the show for your reference:

1. Theme

“Leveraging Innovation and Investment for Building Resilient and Sustainable Agri-Food Systems”.

2. Registration

3. Allowed Products in the exhibition

Agriculture and livestock's inputs, products (primary and processed products), materials and equipment as well as agribusinesses and technologies used to improve food security are solely accepted in the exhibition.

4. Status of the stands.

92 Exhibition stands are already constructed. For having access to the constructed stands, the Rwandan exhibitors must pay 5000 Rwf.

Rwandan exhibitors who don't have access to the constructed stands, plots to construct their own stand by using tend will be availed to them by the organizing committee upon their arrival.

Foreigners are required to pay 100 USD to have access to the constructed stands as well as to the open spaces.

Exhibitors are supposed to bring their goods on the first day of the exhibition.

5. Fees for exhibition stands

Each stand will be allocated to exhibitor at 100 USD for foreigners' individual or company who are operating in Rwanda and outside and 5 000 RWF for Rwandan exhibitors or companies. Fees mentioned above will be paid at the Account number 1000007443 of MINAGRI- RIF 2 in the National Bank of Rwanda.

The following exhibitors are exempted for registration fees:

- Sponsors;
- Rwandan exhibitors who constructed their own stands/tent;
- Exhibitors supported by MINAGRI and its institutions;
- MINAGRI and Its institutions

6. Clearing of goods

Exhibitors bringing exhibits to Rwanda are advised to observe the followings:

- Have your goods inspected by SGS
- Appoint a Clearing and Forwarding Agent to handle your goods from the point of origin up to Rwanda border or Kigali International Airport from where the Clearing Agent in Rwanda will take over.

7. Customs Duty

Exhibits brought into Rwanda for the purpose of the show will be duty free.

8. Transportation

The cost for transportation of exhibitors from their respective residence to the showground and vice versa will be supported by themselves.

9. Mounting of exhibits

Exhibitors are required to mount their exhibits one day before the opening of the exhibition.

10. Sale of exhibits

Exhibitors will be allowed to sale their exhibits

11. Tax

Sales during the National Agrishow will be taxed in accordance with relevant laws and regulations.

12. Entry Fee

Entrance to the exhibition will be free of charge

13. Car park

All cars will be parked in an area designated as the car park. Cars 'owners are requested to lock their cars. Cars parked in unauthorized area will be towed away

14. Electricity and Water

Electricity and water will be provided free of charge to exhibitors who will need it. Commercial packaged drinking water will be available on purchase.

15. Removal of exhibits from the showground

No exhibits will be removed from the exhibition stands before the closing day on 20th June 2025 unless permission is granted on request

16. Refreshments

There will be refreshment and food for sale in the showground

17. First aid

There will be a Red Cross Centre for first aid and lost children

18. Fire precaution

No fire of any description will be allowed in the showground except those especially authorized for the official caterers and in cooking areas. No oil lamps are allowed and those exhibitors who wish their attendants to have light must provide them with electronic torches

19. Security

The Ministry will provide general security but exhibitors are advised to make their own arrangements to supplement the general security provided by the Ministry, especially to lock up their vehicles, motorcycles

20. Loss of exhibits

While the Ministry desires to do everything possible to safeguard the interests of exhibitors, the Ministry will not accept any responsibility for loss or theft of exhibits

21. Insurance

Exhibitors are advised to take insurance coverage for their exhibits for the show period

22. Disposal of rubbish

Rubbish and all forms of garbage will be disposed of designated dumping place

23. Opening and closing time

The exhibition will open daily from 7.00 a.m. and close at 7.00 p.m.

24. Night time

No exhibition activities are allowed at night
